

**Onsted Village Council  
Special Council Meeting  
May 29, 2018**

**5:30 PM**

Meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by President Bailey. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Council present: Armstrong, Bailey, Cannon, Newell, Shoemaker, Schultz, Wolverton, Treasurer and Clerk. Also present: Sandy Bannan, Sally Hazen, Kathy Foelich, Michelle Pfeffer, and Abby Moore.

The "friends of park" presented their proposal to repair the large piece of equipment in the park. Much discussion ensued. Motion to tear out the large piece of equipment and the Park committee, OCRC and the "friends" will meet and have a proposal ready for a new piece of equipment by the next council meeting. Motion was made by Cannon, second by Schultz. Voice vote: Armstrong, yes. Cannon, yes. Newell, yes. Shoemaker, yes. Schultz, yes. Wolverton, yes. Bailey, yes. Motion carried.

We received three bids, Bradys, Slusarski and K&B. Jack to get with them to clarify the bids. Jack, Ron and Jeff to meet with Onsted School to see if they wish to invest in the shoulders by the school during the project. Committee will have everything ready for Monday's meeting.

Jeff, Caleb and Jack went to Ohio to drive a CASE backhoe. Jeff to get a firm quote by Monday.

OCRC is looking into acquiring the Onsted Soccer Club program. They would like to move the soccer games to the park rather than the Slee Rd complex. They would also like to leave the banners up around the ball fields until September. Bailey addressed the concern of the "naming" of one of the fields- OCRC said they would be happy to address the issue at some point. They are also gathering information to do some major park improvements and plan on keeping the council fully informed on any and all progress made.

Motion to purchase plate compactor from TC's for \$1,500 was made by Schultz, second by Wolverton. All ayes, motion carried.

Sewer ordinance is still in progress.

RAVE was approved. Alert needs to come from an elected official. Information will be in the newsletter.

Motion to adjourn the special meeting at 6:37pm was by Schultz, second by Armstrong. All ayes, Motion carried.
